As the Village continues to be fiscally responsible to its residents the Finance and Economic Development Committee works diligently to make certain that all Department Directors follow the Financial Management Policies and Procedures Ordinance as well as the Procurement Policy Ordinance adopted by the Village Board. These Ordinances were adopted in 2015 at a time when Village Officials recognized that changes in the current procedures were needed to ensure the financial stability of the Village.

The Financial Management Policies and Procedures clarifies the roles, authority, and responsibilities for essential financial management activities and decisions. It spells out budget, revenue, expenditures, reserve, capital improvement, debt and financial reporting policies. While the goal of the Procurement Policy is to obtain quality goods and services at the lowest possible price. The purpose of this Policy is to establish guidelines to achieve this goal. These Policies along with enhancements to the Village's Finance Department have proven to be successful as we continue to see improvements in the Village's financial position.

Looking for some summer fun? Make sure to mark your calendar on June 27-30 for River Grove's River Front Fest. While this is an old tradition in River Grove, this year will have a lot of new flavor! Music, Food, Carnival, a Duck Race and more, you will find it all at River Front Park (Grand Avenue and Ditka Drive) by the gazebo.

If it is food you are looking for, you will be able to enjoy a variety of specialties from local restaurants such as; Marias, D'Agostinos, Atheme, Ada's, DaLuciano's, River Café, Tri Café and Hala Kahiki, and more. Fest hours are Thursday 5 to 10 p.m., Friday 5 to 11 p.m., Saturday 1 to 11 p.m. and Sunday 1 to 9 p.m.

This year we have a new carnival provider in AAA Amusements. All of their rides are sure to thrill young and old alike. People may stop at the Village Hall and pre buy wristband at a price of \$50 for all four days! Also, on Friday, June 28 Mayor David Guerin and the Village Board are hosting a Friends with Disabilities Day which will provide free carnival rides to kids with disabilities and their families between 2 and 4 p.m. that day.

If you are a music buff, the lineup for this year's fest will knock your socks off with a variety of offerings the whole family will enjoy. Thursday night will kick off with Prairie Station, a local country band, and Ladies Night will close the evening with songs to keep everyone on their feet. Friday night, coming back from last year, are favorites Hello Weekend and Hair Band Night. Saturday afternoon in the park will start with the Chicago Experience with songs from the band Chicago. Hinge will take the stage from 6 to 8 p.m. and finishing the night will be High Infidelity. Sunday's line up is all local groups! Starting at 1 p.m., Anthony Rago will be singing the tunes from the Great American Songbook (Tony Bennet, Frank Sinatra and more...). Mistaken Identity will play from 3:30 to 5:30 p.m. and finishing out the fest as always is River Grove's very own and favorite, The Pondhawks, featuring songs from the Monkey's, Beatles and more.

The final day of the Fest will also include the annual Duck Race down the Des Plaines River. People are able to purchase Duck Race tickets at the village hall from now until the event and then there will be a booth for ticket sales at the fest. All proceeds from the Duck Race go to benefit the River Grove Beautification Committee.
