Village of River Grove – Construction Update

- By the time this newsletter is out, construction will have begun on the Oak, Maple and Wood Street alleys. Letters describing the construction plan were handed out to residents in the area. Street sweeping parking restrictions will be lifted on Oak, Maple, and Wood Streets to allow for added parking during construction. Garbage trucks will pick up curbside instead of in the alley. Please call (708) 453-8000 if you have questions regarding the project.
- There will also be street improvement on Tarpey Lane to the alley between Grand and Center Streets. The village is allocating for off street parking to help the lack of parking spaces along Grand Ave. and to alleviate parking congestion in the area.
- The village is also constructing a concrete alley between Marwood Street and Budd Street north of Grand Ave.

Our November shout out goes to one of our food pantry administrators, **Billie O'Connor**. Billie moved to River Grove in 1972 with her husband Denis and 3 children, the late Kathie (former trustee), Mary and Denis Jr. Since that time she has volunteered with many organizations. She was on the Rhodes School PTA and held the President title for a time, she was district director for the Illinois PTA, a Campfire leader, a Cub Scout den leader, she coached girls' softball through the village and taught CCD at St. Cyprian's. Billie also enjoys reading, crocheting and gardening. She is the grandma of three; Danny, Jack and Mia. Billie began working at the River Grove food pantry in 2013. Today she works there with Sue Flemm and Janice Campbell. The food pantry is open every Tuesday and Thursday from 9 to 11:30 a.m. and the second Saturday of every month from 10 a.m. to noon. To be eligible to use the River Grove food pantry a person must be a River Grove resident and fill out a simple form (no financial questions). A person can use the food pantry once a month. Billie stated that they help at least 40 families every month and some only when they need it. 75% of their customers are senior citizens. Billie said that their busiest time of year is around the holidays.
