Street Improvements **The dust has been flying on Village improvements this year!**

Finley Street Improvements: The water main replacement and sewer improvement have been completed.

The contractor will begin replacing the existing lead water services pipes with copper, as well as completing the restoration of the roadway in the coming month.

2021 Roadway Improvements: The Village awarded a contract to Brothers Asphalt Paving, the low bidder for the project. The project addresses several sections of street that were rated very low in the pavement condition survey completed for the Village by CMAP. The following streets are being improved:

1. Palmer Avenue from Leyden to Fifth
2. Trumbull Avenue from Palmer to Belden
3. Belden Avenue from Trumbull to Fifth
4. Beulah Avenue from Chestnut to Franklin
5. Belden Avenue from Finley to West



2021 Sidewalk Program: The Village will be replacing \$100,000 in trip spots on the village's main sidewalk.

J Nardulli Concrete, Inc. was the low bidder for the second year in a row; we look forward to having the sidewalk completed by the middle of November. To be considered for next year's program please contact Public Works at (708) 452-7055 so your location can be added to the list.

2021 Pavement Patching Program: The Village will also be completing a pavement patching program with Brothers Asphalt Paving. The primary focus is on Elm Street and Spruce Street between Fullerton and Grand.

2021 Water Meter Project: Calumet City Plumbing is still making progress on the installing of the new meter registers on the system. The Village is very thankful for all the cooperation it has received thus far on the program.

Lost and Found: Pet Edition

When the River Grove Police Department is notified of a stray animal it is their goal to return it to its owner. RGPD no longer has a place to bring stray animals for holding so they may ask the finder to hold the animal if possible, until the owner can retrieve their pet. If your pet is out loose, you can receive a citation. Check that your gates latch properly and train your pet to only go out the door when invited. Pets do get out, it happens, so give your pet the best chance to get back home. Please make sure your pet is microchipped and the microchip information is updated. Your pet should be wearing a collar with tags that include the village registration tag and a nametag with an address and phone number. **On Saturday November 6th there will be a free Rabies Vaccination / Microchip Clinic in the Village Hall parking lot.** This is co-hosted by Mayor Guerin and the Anti-Cruelty Society. Presented in partnership with the Cook County Department of Animal and Rabies Control and Cook County Commissioner Peter Silvestri, 9th District.

Senior Snow Removal Program

The Village of River Grove and East Leyden High School students have partnered to assist River Grove senior citizens with snow removal. A shovel may need to be provided, the Village will verify with the students. The rate will be \$10.00 per house and includes the following:

- A path from your front door to your sidewalk/street/stairs
- A path from your back door to your garage door

Additional charges will apply for the following and will be discussed and handled with the student that is assisting you:

- Salting (resident must provide)
- Shoveling driveways, carport, parking space(s)
