Dear Friendly Neighbors,

First and foremost, I want to ask our residents to continue to pray for the people of Ukraine. River Grove is proud of our European population, many of whom are Ukrainian. As many of you know, my wife's family is of Ukrainian decent and we pray for a quick resolution to this war as well as for the safety of the family and friends of our residents. Our Public Works has started the installation of our first ever playground to service our Thatcher Woods and O'Connor Drive area. Many residents have asked for a park in this area and the Village Board is listening. I am happy to announce that the park includes a soccer net, all exclusive playground equipment and shaded seating will be up and running this summer. The park is fenced in for safety. We are looking forward to seeing you at the park dedication ceremony to be announced this summer. This park was paid for entirely by TIF funds generated by the shopping center and, in turn, adding this amenity will encourage future sales and sales tax. The Village Board remains committed to enhancing green space and increasing the value of your property.

We have some exciting events coming up soon including our Easter Egg Hunt, Arbor Day, Cinco De Mayo Senior Bingo, and River Front Fest...just to name a few. Our River Grove Rockets Softball and Little League Baseball are ready to be in full swing.
