
### RGPD Training

During the first two weekends in March, Training Officers Kross, Cunningham, and Mellett conducted in-house **High-Risk Traffic Stop training for all certified River Grove Police Officers including police administrators**. This specific in-house training program was created to meet a recently established state training mandate that certified officers must complete periodically. The training officers put the "trainees" through four different hands-on practical training scenarios which required the trainees to act as a group to accomplish certain tasks using decision-making and communication skills. During the training scenarios, officers utilized safe "blue" guns and "blue" tasers which are not operational, and role players (made up of volunteers) made the training simulations realistic. This valuable in-house training is the first to occur within the police department, and additional in-house training sessions will follow.



## Arbor Day 2024 in River Grove

Since 1872, Arbor Day (the last Friday of April) has been recognized as a time to plant and appreciate trees. The Village of River Grove celebrates this day with a tree-planting ceremony. The 6th graders from both River Grove and Rhodes Schools attend, and they participate in a wood flower decorating contest. This year, on Friday April 26th at 10am, the Village of River Grove and the River Grove Beautification Committee along with the Public Works Department will be planting a tree at the River Grove Historical House in honor of Historical Commission member Nancy Hansen who recently passed away. ## Village Implements New On-Line Billing for Water/Sewer/Refuse Payments

As of mid-February, you will have noticed that the Village has implemented a new billing system for its utilities including water, sewer and refuse services. Invoice Cloud is a system that interfaces with the Village's accounting system and provides enhanced improvements on how residents and business will pay their utility bills going forward. Enhancements not previously offered include options for receiving billing invoices by email versus the postal service and the ability to set up an automatic payment from a credit card or bank account on the bill's due date, meaning you will never be late on a utility bill again. With a month into the new program, 577 (approximately 22%) residents and businesses have opted for paperless billing and 229 (approximately 9%) have already set up their accounts for automatic payments. **Please see the Village website for additional details or you can call 708-452-7055 or by email to [waterbilling@rivergroveil.gov](mailto:waterbilling@rivergroveil.gov).**
