October is Fire Prevention month, making it a perfect time to check your smoke detectors and change their batteries. I would like to highlight an infrastructure upgrade that is so important to the health and wellness of our community. The street and water main improvements to 3000 and 3100 block of Elm St. are currently underway. This involves the installation of new water mains, the replacement of lead water services, new curbs, sidewalks and driveways at various locations. As well as roadway patching and landscaping. This project is scheduled for completion in early December.


New Street Maintenance Signs are Coming to River Grove

You may have already noticed new street maintenance signs being installed around town. It won't be long before they're placed on your street as well. Please note: your designated street maintenance day will remain the same. The main updates you'll see involve overnight resident parking and snow removal. These changes will take effect Village-wide starting November 1, 2025. The new resident-only overnight parking policy is being implemented to prevent unauthorized non-resident vehicles from parking on our streets. The goal is to keep overnight street parking available for River Grove residents. To park overnight on Village streets, vehicles must display a valid River Grove vehicle sticker and the vehicle must be registered to the resident. The snow removal signage has been updated for greater clarity. River Grove Public Works Director Brock Leder explained, **"We feel the new language for snow removal will help residents better understand when and where to move their car when it snows."** These changes are part of the Village's ongoing efforts to improve safety, accessibility, and quality of life for our residents.



River Grove Historical Signs Information

Were you aware that the events during the Battle of Fort Dearborn on August 15, 1812, had a profound impact on the shape of our Village and much of the surrounding area. We are fortunate to reside in a Village with such a rich and diverse history. River Grove is the oldest Village in Leyden Township. Which is why it is important that we preserve our historical knowledge and heritage. Furthermore, we should feel compelled to inform our residents and educate our children and future generations about the history of our Village. One period of particular interest that is often overlooked or neglected is the pre-history of our Village: The events just before River Grove's incorporation that figuratively and literally shaped our Village. In an effort to further educate and enlighten residents, new and old, we have installed several historical signs around town. The 4 signs that have been installed thus far are shown in the image below. Additional signs are being considered for our schools and the oldest places of worship. Another goal/objective being pursued is to erect a special bronze sign that will commemorate Senf Hall, the site where our Village was incorporated back in 1888. This will likely require some fundraising and donation initiatives. Keep an eye out for the new historical information signs as you drive around town. Kudos to the River Grove Fire Department Team!

This past summer, the River Grove Fire Department encountered a deaf resident while responding to an unfounded fire alarm at an apartment building in River Grove. The resident later contacted the firehouse through an interpreter to inquire about the visit and spoke with Kim Stewart, our Fire Administrator. During their conversation, Kim learned that the resident had a strobe light for fire alerts but lacked a bed shaker—a critical device for alerting individuals while they sleep. Kim researched available resources and discovered that the **Illinois Fire Safety Alliance/Camp I Am Me** could donate a bed shaker through their **Be Alarmed/Safe Awake Program** (Program Director: Jeff Zaleski). Once the department received it, RGFD Lt. Jeff Leiser personally installed the bed shaker in the resident's home. According to Chief Sean Flynn, the specialized alert system, which includes both a traditional smoke detector and a vibrating bed shaker, is designed to provide early warning in the event of a fire. It is especially vital for individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing and may not be able to hear standard alarms. The bed shaker activates simultaneously with the smoke detector, ensuring that residents are alerted even while asleep. Chief Flynn added, **“What a great program and what an outstanding team effort in making sure every member in our community is protected from fire, regardless of ability.”**



Important Reminder and Helpful Hints:

- The deadline for the Village vehicle stickers to be on residents' cars **was September 30, 2025**. If you haven't yet purchased yours, please go to the Village Hall.
- **Here are some ideas to conserve water at home:** fix leaks, take shorter showers, turn off the tap while brushing teeth or shaving, and only run dishwashers and washing machines with full loads.
