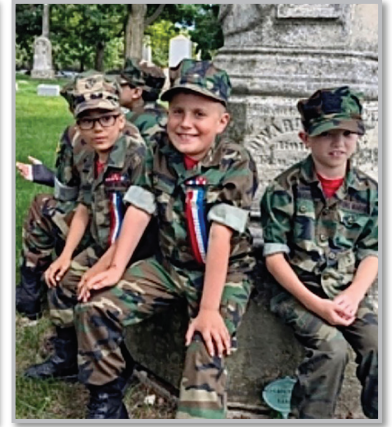

River Grove Police Officers Honored

It's always rewarding to be appreciated for a job well done. Recently, Chief Mike Konwinski remarked, **"It's always a proud moment for me when I have the opportunity to recognize some of our outstanding officers!"** The Alliance Against Intoxicated Motorists awarded certificates of appreciation to River Grove police officers **Michael Cwik, Tom Krupa, Tony Ikis, Logan McGarry, and Jerry Lucas** for exceptional DUI enforcement through July 2025. Many of these officers have carried that high level of performance over from last year, and all of them continue to perform their duties at the highest standard daily. Mayor Dave Guerin added, **"Our police officers are some of the finest in the area. I am confident and proud that our residents can feel safe with them on patrol."**

Honoring Veterans and the Young Marines

The month of November always reminds us of our Veterans and how grateful we are for their service. Did you know that here in River Grove, we have an established Young Marines program for boys and girls ages 8 through 18. One of the places they train at is the River Grove American Legion/VFW. These kids drill twice a month on the second and fourth Saturday. They have class from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. They learn physical fitness, public speaking, leadership, and basic life skills such as ironing, shining shoes, and much more. Recently, one of these Young Marines,



Christian Alba, who is nine years old, saved a friend's life at the summer carnival at St. Borgia, which was documented in a police report. Christian was subsequently awarded a second-degree life-saving award and a meritorious promotion to Private First Class.

According to the River Grove unit's founder and Unit Commander, Sgt. Richard Wojewnik **"A Young Marine will start off as a private, but depending on how much they do, how much they want to participate in, what schools they want to attend, they can retire at age 18, at the rank of Sgt Major."** The Young Marines started in 1959, recognized by the Marine Corps League, and the Marine Corps in 1965. They've been in the Chicagoland area since 1980. He went on to state, **"The Young Marines are from all over the Chicagoland area and beyond. Currently, there are 26 members in the Unit, eight of whom are young ladies."**

This Veterans Day, Tuesday, November 11, at 11 a.m., please join us at our newly built Veterans Memorial, which is located at Grand Ave. and Indian Boundary, where we will honor Veterans we have lost and Veterans who are still with us. This is also an excellent opportunity to purchase a paver to honor a loved one. You can also purchase a paver from your family to show support for the Veterans.
