NATIONAL NIGHT OUT: August 7th

On Tuesday, August 7th River Grove is joining forces with thousands of communities nationwide for the "35th Annual National Night Out" crime and drug prevention event. National Night Out, which is sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch and co-sponsored by the village of River Grove. This event will involve over 16,500 communities from all 50 states.

National Night Out is designed to: (1) Heighten crime and drug prevention awareness; (2) Generate support for, and participation in, local anti-crime efforts; (3) Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships; and (4) send a message to criminals letting them know neighborhoods are organized and fighting back.

From 5 to 9 p.m. on August 7th, residents in River Grove and across the nation, are asked to lock their doors, turn on outside lights and spend the evening outside with village and police. River Grove will be hosting a special event at River Front Park. This will include a cookout, visits from River Grove Police and Fire, youth activities, games, a face painter and anti-crime rallies. THE FULLERTON AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS ARE UNDERWAY

The Illinois Department of Transportation is completing the section of Fullerton Avenue from Webster Street to First Avenue, which is their section of roadway. The improvements include the repair to certain sections of curb and gutter, sidewalk improvements at the street crossing, repairs to drainage structures as needed, the milling of the existing asphalt, pavement patching and the placement of new asphalt and pavement stripping. The work is being completed by Arrowroad Construction of Mount Prospect. The work began in July and is anticipated to be completed by the end of August.
