Avalon Equities indicated that it anticipates coffee being first brewed around September 2019.

FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The Public Works Department is excited and looking forward to receiving five new vehicles over the next few months. In early December, we expect to take delivery of three, Ford F-250 Pick Up trucks which will be replacing existing trucks that each range between fourteen to twenty years old. The new trucks will be customized with plow packages, light bars and signage. We will also be taking delivery of one Ford F-150 truck which is replacing an existing 2001 truck and will be used by our landscaping crew. Lastly, we have on order, a Ford F-750 "3-ton" Dump Truck. This vehicle requires more extensive customization, so is expected in early 2019, and will replace an existing 1997 Dump Truck. These new vehicles are a welcome addition to the department and our crews are looking forward to these much needed upgrades.
